Designing Information Technology for Organizational Change

In this workshop a general method will be introduced for enabling the construction of models that connect numerous design theories with alternative solutions. Its utility will be illustrated with an application to a case of organizational change, enabled by the evaluation and application of alternative design options for IT-based systems.

Jan Pries-Heje is Professor in Information Systems and Head of the User Driven IT-innovation research Group, CBIT RUC (Roskilde Universitetscenter). Research Manager for several projects (currently a 16 millions. DKK project called SourceIT), Jan Pries-Heje holds MSc and PhD degrees from Copenhagen Business School. He previously held positions at the IT University of Copenhagen and at the IT University in Gothenburg. Prof. Jan Pries-Heje published extensively and is currently Associate Editor for *MIS Quarterly*, *Information Systems Journal*, and *European Journal of Information Systems*; three of the top 10 journals in the field of Information Systems. He has written 14 books, 27 chapters in books, 27 peer-reviewed journal papers and 59 peer-reviewed conference papers.
